Dear Mr. Benavides:

On April 17, 2003, the Dallas Police and Fire Pension System filed suit against the Texas Attorney General in the 353rd Judicial District Court, Cause No. GN301225 ([Exhibit "A"](#)), to block the release of billings from the law firm of Lawson Fields McCue Lee & Campbell, P.C. ([Exhibit "B"](#)), ruled subject to public disclosure by the Office of the Texas Attorney General.

Pursuant to the Texas Public information Act (Texas Open Records Act), Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, please provide the following information regarding the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System, its employees, and its Board of Trustees (collectively, the "Pension System"):

1. Identify all legal documents filed by or on behalf of the Pension System in the above noted cause of action. Please include the date-of-filing and a brief description of each document.

Should documents responsive to this request not be available, please note that there is also considerable knowledge within the Pension System to include its Chairman who, according to the Pension System's website, has served the Board of Trustees continuously since 1983.
